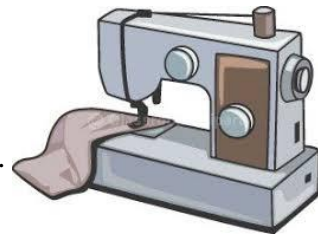
Because there was not a Board Meeting on Dec. 6, there are no minutes to report.
