Our January speaker, Emily Hardwig, gave us a wonderful trunk show that highlighted her Red Button Patterns. In February we will get to meet another Minnesota pattern designer. Cindy Staub's patterns are called Quilt Doodle Designs. She will be coming from Burnsville, so I hope the weather conditions are good.

The President's Challenge this year is inspired by vintage yard long advertisement prints. The 12-inch by 36-inch quilt that you make can be used as an art quilt for narrow spaces or as a table runner. It can have a vintage flare or be a modern design. It can easily be made from three 12-inch blocks or be a landscape. You could use up lots of tiny scraps or apply decorations to a beautiful piece of fabric. You will need a label on the back. It will be fun to see all these quilts in our quilt show this fall.
