See you all in 2015!



Your work and generosity is AMAZING. Here are the yearly totals.

<u>Project 1: Nurse Family Partnership and Healthy Families America</u> Seventy-nine quilts and ninety receiving size blankets from Project Linus were given to Stearns County Public Health to use with young families and for parent education.

<u>Project 2: Breaking Free</u> Thirty-nine quilts and six pillow cases were made and donated to this organization which helps women 'breaking free' from sex trafficking.

**Project 3: Patient Bags for Coborn Cancer Center** Thirty-seven patient bags were donated at our December meeting. To date I have delivered 747 bags to the cancer center. This includes the 342 that were sewn on the work days organized by Fawn.
