**SCHQ BOARD MINUTES****Marilyn Bujalski**

Members present: Marilyn Bujalski (secretary), Marlyn Anderson (co-president), Karen Cyson (special events), Terri Bahn (program chair), Fawn Wright (membership), Kathy Crabtree (small groups), Brooke Strassburg (treasurer 2015) Terri Olson (co-president)

Meeting was called to order at 5:45 pm.

Motion by Karen Cyson, second by Kathy Crabtree, to approve the minutes as presented for the March 2016 meeting. Motion carried by majority vote of all members present.

**BOARD REPORTS:**

**Programs** (Terri Bahn): Terri reported that she is still working on coordinating the demo program for in the summer. The October meeting will be the guild birthday party and also she would like to do a flea market. This was done in the past and was successful. There was a discussion about doing this on a weekend rather than at a guild meeting because of time constraints. No final decision was reached. The December meeting will be pot luck with games and time to socialize.

**Membership** (Fawn Wright): Fawn reported there are 146 members. Fawn said there was a software communication problem in getting the old members who have not re-joined removed from the current paid member list. Some former members are still getting newsletters according to Kathy. Fawn will e-mail the membership list to Kathy to put into drop box as Fawn doesn't know how to do this. Current information can be accessed from there.

**Small Groups** (Kathy Crabtree and Mary Plas): Mary was not present so Kathy reported that there are only 2 people signed up for the row robin group and no one has signed up for the brown bag group. She will discuss with membership at meeting.

**Secretary** (Marilyn Bujalski): Marilyn commented to board that in sending out draft minutes for review, she got multiple comments on the same change and after revision and resending the minutes the same comments were made again even though changes were made. Marlyn Anderson felt that this was because some people weren't actually reading the minutes all the way through. Marilyn also asked the board try to have only one discussion at a time as occasional several members are engaged in different discussions on different subjects making it hard to take accurate minutes. Marilyn also requested that near the end of each meeting, board members not leave to do other things until adjournment has been made.

**Treasurer** (Mary Proell and Mary Ann Smith): Brooke presented report for both Mary Proell and Mary Ann Smith who were not present. She did not have a printed report for review. Kathy commented that the treasurer's report should be in the newsletter every month. No balances were reported to the board. There was discussion about ending the automatic payment for certain expenses such as website hosting. It would be easier to track if checks were written. Fawn and Brooke have the only two keys to the post office box. Brooke commented that she found a private party who would redo the guild website at a cost of \$2,800. Board members felt this cost was too high and that it would be worthwhile to check into other options. Kathy and Marilyn agreed to work with Maggie Voigt to design and host a new updated website.

**Special Events** (Karen Cyson): Karen reported that two classes were held on paper piecing and were well attended. On April 18<sup>th</sup> there will be a workshop on hand applique. This group will meet at the public library from 6-8:45pm. Members are invited to come to participate, observe, or work on something of their own. Karen will have a handout for the workshop on Shibori dying. She showed samples of this technique to the board. The cost for the 5 hour workshop is \$75 and includes the dyes that will be used. Members will furnish their own PFD (prepared for dying) fabric. The basket weaving workshop will be in mid-summer.

**President** (Marlyn Anderson, Terri Olson): Terri was late to the board meeting. Marlyn reported that she called the church in advance of the meeting about setting up the chairs and that they said a fee of \$75 must be paid if a different arrangement of the tables and chairs is desired. Marlyn asked that board members all help with putting away tables and chairs at the end of the meeting. There will be an update of the Constant Contact software program at a later meeting.

**Adjournment:** Motion by Kathy Crabtree, Second by Fawn Wright to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried by majority vote of all members present. Meeting was adjourned at 6:22 pm.
